

King's Cross floor plan

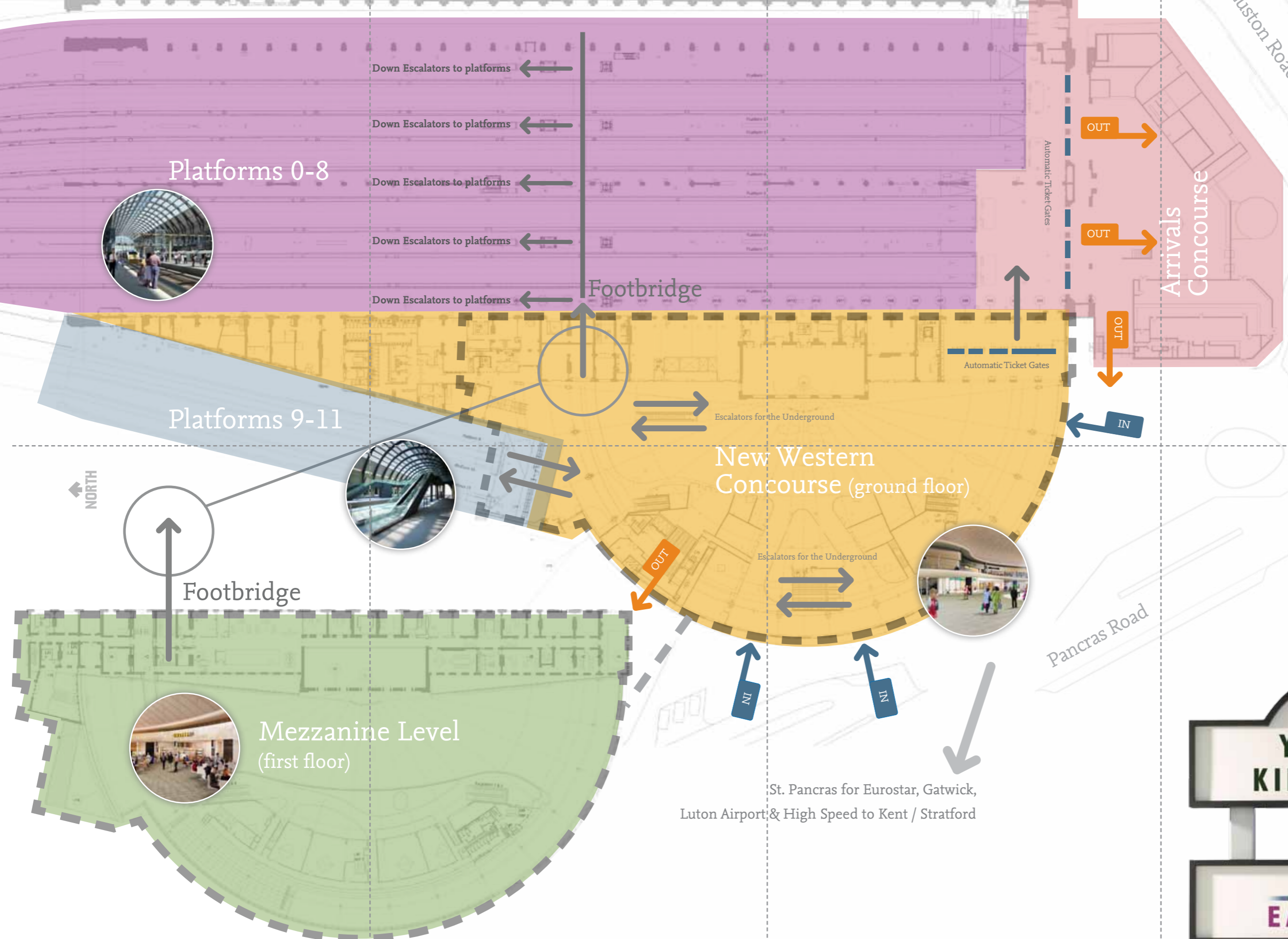
Finding your way around King's Cross

From 19 March, you'll notice some big changes to how you get around King's Cross. This has been designed to ensure your journey experience is as smooth as possible.

When catching a train from King's Cross, you'll need to enter the station into the new Western concourse and make your way to the platform from here.

A new entrance from King's Cross / St. Pancras underground station will bring you directly into the Western concourse. This will be clearly signposted as you exit the underground ticket gates.

When arriving into King's Cross by train, you'll exit the station in the same way you do now – either onto the street or down to the underground. As this area will be for arrivals only, you'll find it much easier to get where you're heading to.

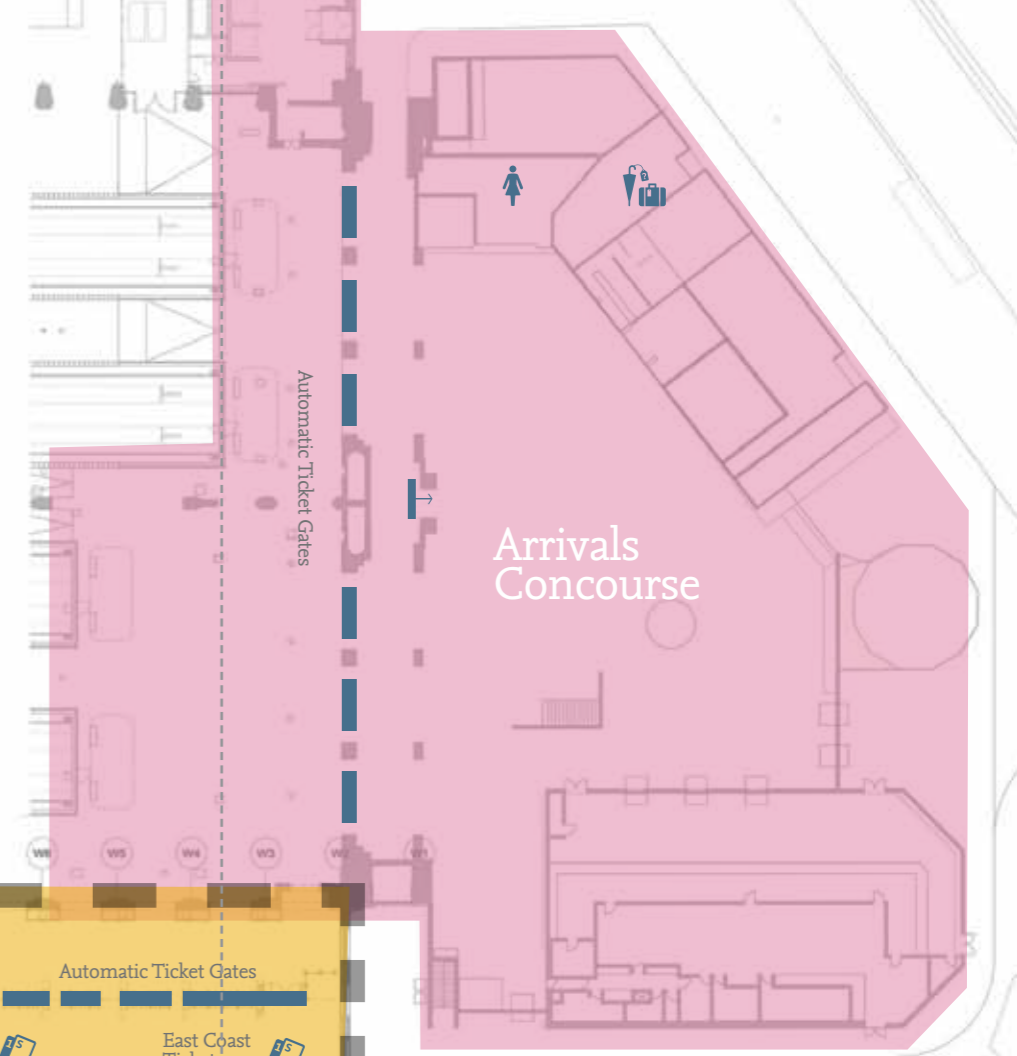

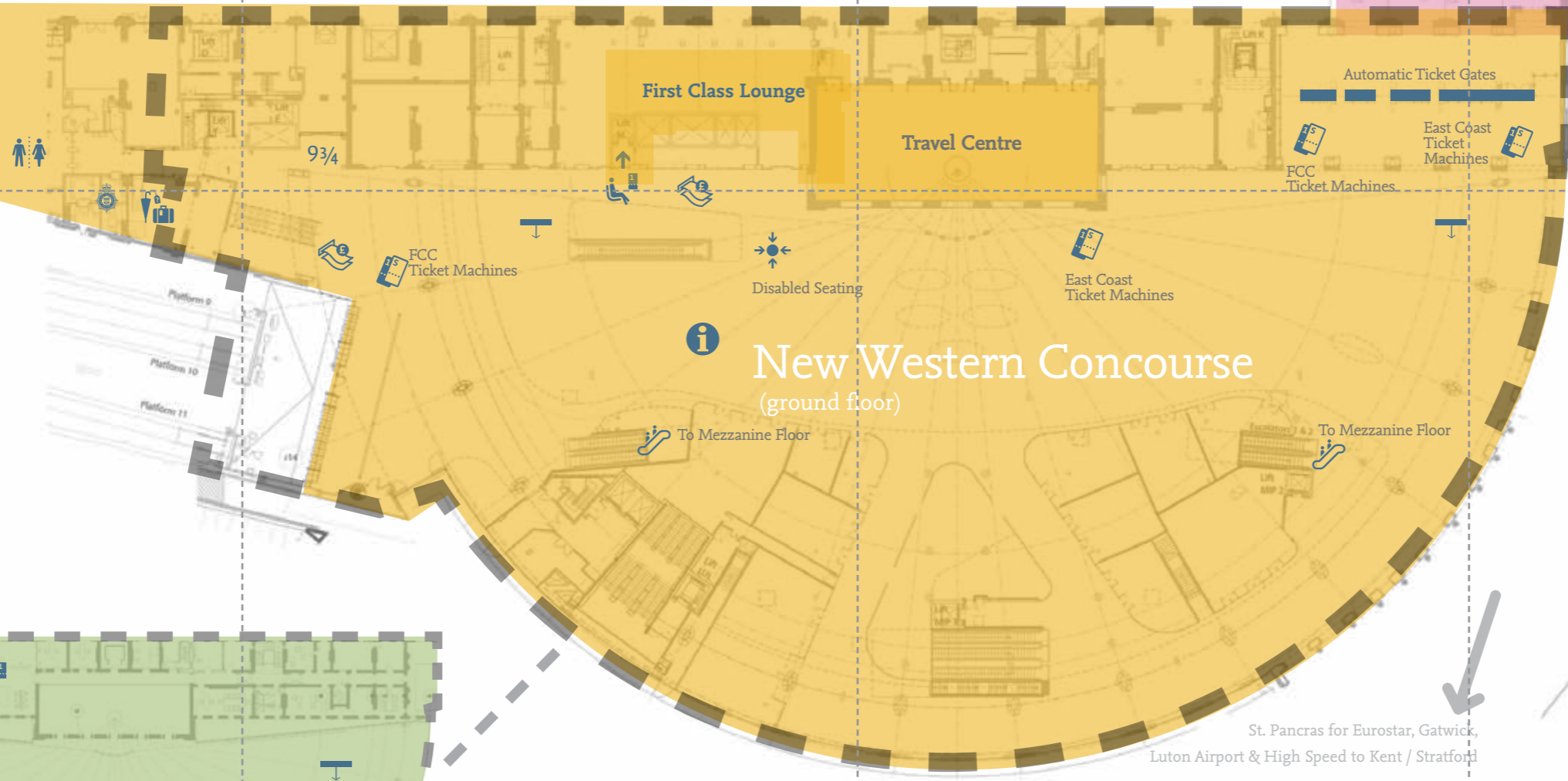

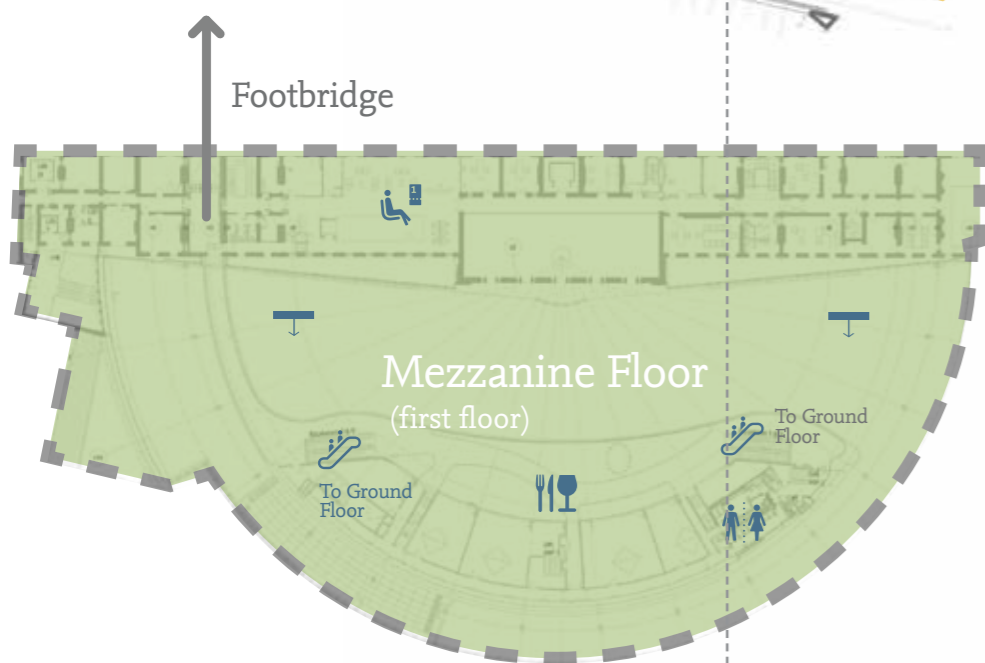
